Writing Foundations

Grades K-12 | 1:1 Academic Support

Writing can feel overwhelming for students of any age. At My Learning Farm, writing instruction is explicit, structured, and individualized, supporting students from the earliest stages of writing through advanced academic composition.

Instruction includes **writing support for:** letter formation and handwriting mechanics, sentence structure, paragraph writing, report writing, expository writing, informational writing, persuasive writing, summaries, short-answer responses, identifying key words in writing prompts, using outlines to plan multi-paragraph compositions and essays, adding detail, elaboration, and voice, and understanding and responding to complex writing prompts across subject areas.



Every student begins with an initial writing assessment to determine strengths and areas for growth. Instruction is delivered 1:1, in person or via Zoom, and lessons are carefully scaffolded to meet each student exactly where they are—building confidence, clarity, and independence over time.

Reading Foundations

Grades K-12 | 1:1 Academic Support

Reading is a complex skill, and many students benefit from a structured, multisensory approach. Using **Orton-Gillingham Structured Literacy**, instruction focuses on phonics, decoding, blending, fluency, and comprehension.

Students move through a **four-level foundational program** designed to strengthen phonemic awareness, letter-sound relationships, decoding and word reading, reading fluency, and comprehension strategies.



Each student begins with an initial reading assessment for accurate placement. Instruction is individualized, supportive, and delivered 1:1 in person or via Zoom, with pacing and materials matched to the student's learning profile.

Spelling Foundations

Grades K-12 | 1:1 Academic Support

Spelling can feel discouraging for many learners. My Learning Farm utilizes **several evidence-based Orton-Gillingham structured spelling curricula and methodologies**, allowing instruction to be thoughtfully matched to each student's needs.

Each student begins with an **initial spelling assessment**, and the student's **learning profile and learning style** are carefully considered to determine an individualized instructional plan. Instruction is explicit, systematic, and multisensory, helping students understand spelling patterns, rules, and the structure of the English language.

Instruction may include multisensory practice, word analysis, dictation, pattern discovery, and cumulative review. Lessons are delivered 1:1, in person or via Zoom, and are designed to support long-term retention, confidence, and independence in spelling.

Grades K-8 | 1:1 Academic Support

Many students struggle with math facts, multi-step thinking, and mastery of the four operations. Using **Making Math Real®**, math instruction is structured, multisensory, and concept-driven.

Instruction focuses on number sense, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions, multi-operation equations, verbal cues, conceptual models, and hands-on learning through games and manipulatives.

Students begin with an initial math assessment to identify strengths and needs. Instruction is individualized and delivered 1:1 in person or via Zoom.

Attendance, Make-Up & Scheduling Policy

(Applies to 1:1 Academic Support ONLY)

The following policies apply exclusively to one-on-one academic support and do not apply to Farm Classes or My Learning Farm Reads group classes.

Families sign an academic-year contract (August-May). Instruction follows a traditional school-year schedule and includes typical school breaks. Families should refer to the My Learning Farm Academic Calendar for detailed scheduling.

Sessions are billed monthly. August and December are discounted months due to shortened schedules; adjusted pricing is reflected in client contracts.

One complimentary make-up session per semester is offered:

- Fall Semester: August-December
- Spring Semester: January-May

Additional missed sessions are not guaranteed and may not be rescheduled.

Families are encouraged to provide as much notice as possible if a session must be missed. Zoom sessions are available upon request.

If Ms. Sara must cancel a scheduled 1:1 session, the session fee will be credited or refunded.

- Help you evaluate curriculum choices and match resources to your child's needs
- Share practical strategies for daily scheduling, pacing, and balancing subjects



- Offer tailored recommendations for reading, writing, math, spelling, and enrichment

Families receive a **detailed individualized written report** that summarizes discussion points, curriculum suggestions, and actionable next steps, followed by a **post-report phone call** to ensure clarity and help you implement recommendations at home.

Single Subject Academic Assessments

Academic assessments at My Learning Farm go beyond simple scoring — they provide families with a **comprehensive, evidence-based understanding** of a student's current academic skills, strengths, and areas of need, giving you clarity and direction for targeted support.

An academic assessment includes:

- **Up to three 45-minute 1:1 assessment sessions** in the chosen subject (e.g., reading, writing, spelling, or math)
- **A written individualized assessment report** that includes:
 - Performance analysis and skill level
 - Strengths and areas needing support
 - Suggested evidence-based instructional strategies and curriculum recommendations
 - Clear explanations of assessment results in family-friendly language
- **A post-assessment phone meeting** to review results, answer questions, and support next steps

Assessment areas may include phonemic awareness, decoding, fluency, comprehension, sentence structure, writing organization, number sense,



computation, problem solving, spelling patterns, and more — all tailored to the specific skill domain assessed. These assessments are ideal for families seeking insight into learning profiles, instructional planning, or homeschool documentation.

Educational Advocacy

These services are especially valuable for families preparing for or participating in IEP (Individualized Education Plan) and 504 Plan processes.

Advocacy services may include:

- **1:1 consultation and plan review** — analysis of your child's current academic needs, testing data, IEP/504 documentation, and goals
- **IEP & 504 plan preparation** — guidance before meetings to help you understand rights, accommodations, service options, and educational law foundations
- **Goal development support** — help crafting meaningful, measurable academic, behavioral, and functional goals tailored to your child
- **Meeting support & attendance** — virtual or in-person meeting support so you can confidently advocate for appropriate services and accommodations
- **Document review & interpretation** — assistance reading and understanding assessment reports, educational recommendations, progress goals, and service delivery descriptions
- **Service & accommodation recommendations** — identification and explanation of evidence-based supports that maximize access to learning and long-term success
